In honor of Scottdale's 150th Anniversary, there will be four Plein Air Events in and around Scottdale scheduled once a month from May until August. What is Plein Air? 'Painting in the Open Air', thus painting outdoors. It is only \$10 to enter and includes all four dates. We only ask that each artist present at least one of their works for the exhibit to be held during Scottdale's Fall Festival September 20 through 22, 2024. Artists will be advised one month in advance if more than one piece can be submitted. The fee is still \$10. The locations include West Overton, Maple Bottom Farm, Downtown Scottdale and nearby areas. All permissions of these locations will be obtained in Maps will be available upon advance. registration. Start/End times are 10am to 4pm for all sessions however artists are free to come and go as they please. Artists supply all their own material including canvas and paper, paint and easel and don't forget a chair to sit in if needed. Discount lunches will be available for purchase from a number of Scottdale's eateries. All skill levels are invited to participate.

Rules and Guidelines

A fee of \$10 allows an artist to participate in all Plein Air Events held in and around Scottdale May through August. The Scottdale 150th committee just asks the artist submit at least one piece of artwork for sale in the exhibit which will be displayed during Scottdale's Fall Festival. Please see the important dates and locations as well as drop off and pick up dates. A 25% commission on all sales is retained by the Scottdale 150th Committee. There is no fee for Youth Works however if a young artist wants to submit in the 'A' category, they can provided they pay the \$10 fee.

- 1. The artwork must be produced from one of the Plein Air Events.
- 2. Size limitations on finished pieces including frame is 24" high and 36" wide.
- 3. Mediums accepted include oil, water soluble oil, watercolor, acrylic, pencil, charcoal, pastels, and multimedia.
- 4. All skill levels and ages are welcome.
- 5. Artist set the price of work. The committee retains a 25% commission from all sales.
- 6. For the exhibit, all art work shall be framed and utilize D Ring hooks with braided wire suitable for hanging and be complete with finished backs. Sawtooth hangers will not be accepted. All artwork submitted shall attach an **ARTWORK TAG** on the back.
- 7. Artists can take photographs for reference only, but photographs cannot be sold or distributed via social media.
- 8. For YOUTH artists, a responsible adult must accompany the youth at all times.
- 9. Artwork deemed inappropriate for a family event will not be accepted.
